
Step 1: After you sign in, click on the Settings button →



Settings



As a community owner, you will have access to edit any of the settings in the game.

When you create a new community, the game copies all of the settings from the General Public community as a starting point.



The game defaults to a Private community which means that the general public will not be able to join your community when they add a new user. If you want anybody to be able to join your community, change this to Public.

Settings Example



One of the first settings that you will want to edit will be under Career Plan.

After you create a community it will be important to enter in the education requirement for each career opportunity.




Step 1: To create new users (students) for your community, click on the Manage Users button from the settings screen. →
